The applicant must meet the following requirements for eligibility

1. All members of the Associated Student Body of Carlsbad High School, who have earned a non-weighted grade point average of 2.5 or better in both scholarship and citizenship as shown by their most recent grade report card or grade report, shall be eligible for holding office on the Associated Student Body Executive Cabinet. If a candidate has a 2.5 grade point average in either scholarship or citizenship but has an "F" grade or any "N"s or "U"s in any classes, they will not be permitted to hold an executive position.
2. Any school suspensions during the year will result in a student being unable to run for an elected ASB Office. Any school suspensions while in office shall result in immediate removal from office.
3. Satisfactory attendance. A student who has excessive absences or tardies will not be considered for student office. Excessive would be 8 or more unexcused absences and/or 6 tardies to class
4. Candidates must attend the mandatory meeting on 2/27. Meeting details will be emailed to each candidate.
5. A.S.B. and the Administration will review any applicant who does not meet the required criteria and determine eligibility.

CHS Campaign Guidelines for Candidates

There will be no speeches given during class time; we encourage you to speak with students at lunchtime and before school. You are able to promote your campaign on a social media platform as well as creating physical posters to hang around campus. Be sure to read all guidelines on where signs may be placed on campus, how signs can be secured, sign restrictions, and guidelines for a social media post. Further questions for clarification can be directed to the ASB Office. Only signs that have received prior ASB approval may be placed on campus. Signs and flyers cannot be taped to walkways. No chalk, tape or other substances may be applied to walkways, buildings or furniture. Come to room 5004 to make sure your signs are approved.

- **All signs must be hung with blue tape (painter's tape) only** - no masking tape, scotch tape, or duct tape. You may get blue tape from any home improvement store.
- Students must ask permission of instructors to hang signs/flyers on classroom doors or inside an instructor's classroom.
- Signs cannot be placed on any windows, on any building, including windows facing Lancer Way.
- Signs cannot be larger than 3 ft by 6 ft.
- Signs cannot be placed higher than 6 ft off the ground. Do not climb on anything.
- No sign may be placed over another student's poster or removed and replaced.
- Any sign that becomes loose will be taken down, unless secured again by the student.
- A limit of 25 flyers may be placed at any time on campus. Do not print out flyers to hand out.
- Students may campaign via social media, everything must be school appropriate.
- Candidates not following guidelines will be asked to remove their posts and are subject to disciplinary actions.
- No ASB supplies may be used by any candidate running for office.
- No food items may be handed out during campaigning.
- All sign content must meet acceptable guidelines of no inappropriate references.
- Candidates may use T-Shirts to campaign as long as these meet the guidelines. Spending limit of \$50 for all campaign expenses
- Candidates not following guidelines will have signs removed and subject to disciplinary action.
- Poster may go up as early as February 28th, stop by room 5004 for approval of signs by February 27th.
- All candidates must remove signs by 4:00 pm, March 7th .
- All tape must be removed from all surfaces.
- Contact ASB with any questions.
- You must put the URL for voting on all publicity used by candidates.
